The competition saw hundreds of dance athletes battle it out head-to-head in London's biggest all female urban freestyle dance event. After a series of gruelling dance-offs in front of a panel of judges including some of the world's most elite dance professionals, there could only be one winner – Clara Bajado.

Nike was stunned by the strength of undiscovered talent, passion and enthusiasm - it realised it couldn't let the energy created just fade away. Nike recognised these girls as being at the top of their game and so formed D-Clash.
